2.0 Background

The daily average number of new cases of COVID-19 infection is above 6,000 has spurred the government to act and restrict movement by declaring Full Movement Control Order (FMCO) until July 2021. The outbreak also imposed negative impacts on the global economy, industries, corporations and micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs). Consequently, economists predict the slowing down of economic activity momentum started from March 2020 onwards without specific ending date.

Some of the businesses are financially more fragile than larger firms, they own fewer assets and cash reserves, and score lower on productivity levels. As a result, the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on them has been immense. According to the latest survey by the Small and Medium Enterprises Association (SAMENTA), 34% of SMEs experienced a significant decrease in sales of more than 20% in 2020, compared to 2019.

For that reason, this report intends to prepare the insights of the actual implications due to the Full Movement Control Order (FMCO) on businesses and to identify the survival strategies based on the responses of businesses.
