Synopsis	<p>Topic 1: With the damages caused by COVID19 pandemic, the world has changed, and old norms are no more applicable in our way of life and work. For Engineering Consultancy Service, the adoption of the new norm and digitalisation of processes and services is a must for our business to cope with these major changes and to survive. A cost effective yet practical approaches will be shared and discussed.</p> <p>Topic 2: While it is important for Quantity Surveyors (QS) to embark on digitalisation (5D BIM) to keep up with the adoption of Digital Construction Revolution, there are issues that needs to be addressed before QS could excel in the BIM world. One of the important factors is to ensure that the 3D model used from the Architects & Engineers are not solely for visualisation but also able to provide accurate information for quantities extraction and cost of projects. Some examples of the 3D models which prevents information to be extracted and costed accurately would be illustrated. The Royal Institution of Surveyors Malaysia (RISM) has successfully launched the MySMM2020 on 24th July 2020 at Hotel Istana by RISM QS Division which would supersede the Standard Method of Measurement2 (SMM2) used in Malaysia. Case studies on the examples of Bills of Quantities using MySMM2020. The step by step digitalisation of the model mapping & quantities extraction of 5D BIM process will be shared This talk will give an overview of how 5D BIM digitization will equip Quantity Surveyors to embark on Integrated Digital Delivery in the Digital Industrial Revolution world.</p>




WHAT IS not BIM

The non-exhaustive list below provides some examples of models that are **NOT** regarded as BIM:-

- Models that contain 3D data only and have no (or few) object attributes
- Models with no support of behaviour
- Models that are composed of 2D CAD reference files that must be combined to define a building
- Models that allow changes to dimensions in one view that are not automatically reflected in other views

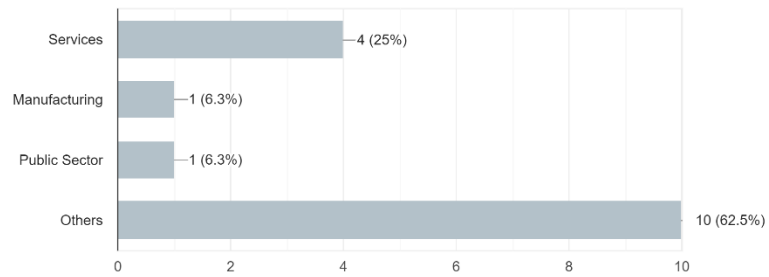

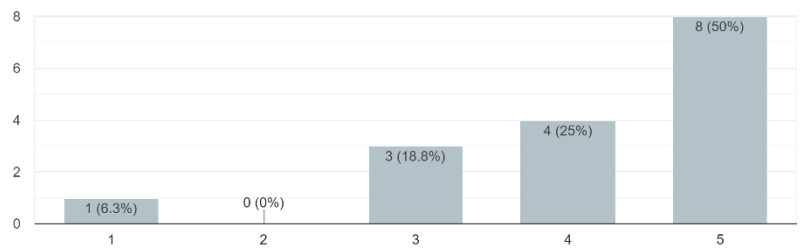

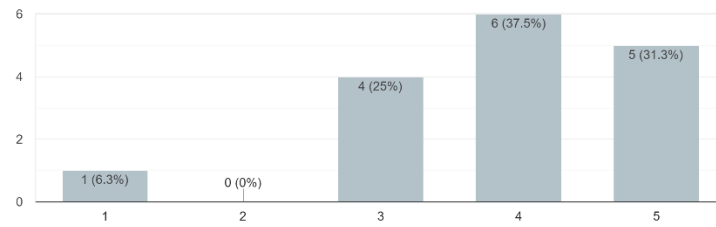

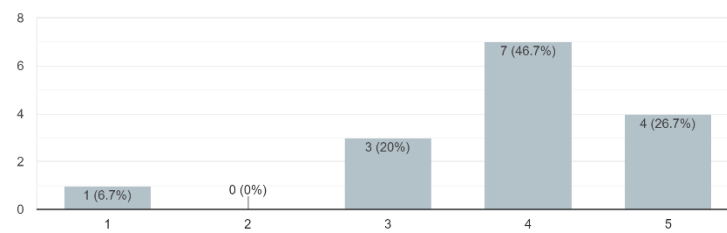

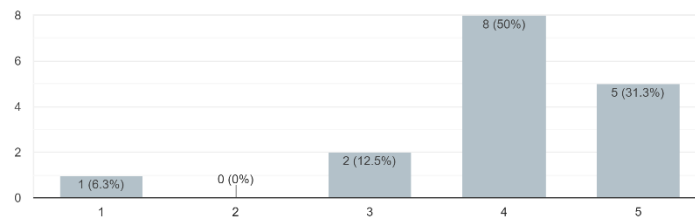
