

Overview

Productivity is the single most important factor in a country's long-term growth. High-productivity nations are able to quickly adapt to changes in macroeconomic challenges, as well as fundamental shifts brought on by technological advancement. Realising the importance of productivity to the nation, the 11MP has specified unlocking the potential of productivity as one of the 6 game-changers for the country to achieve high-income status by 2020. Productivity has been identified as the most vital part in the 11MP's implementation, which calls for renewed efforts to boost productivity in a focussed and targeted manner, with clear outcomes at the national, sectoral, and enterprise levels. The 11MP has introduced the Malaysia Productivity Blueprint (MPB) in May 2017 as a strategy to realise this aspiration.

The blueprint has been designed and developed to accelerate productivity improvement strategies, initiatives and programmes at the national, sectoral and enterprise levels. It provides guided implementation to expedite productivity improvements as envisaged in the 11MP through five strategic thrusts. These thrusts are to ensure holistic and systematic change rather than fragmented efforts.

In striving for higher productivity growth, Malaysia must prepare for uncertain external factors as shifts in economic policies could affect a diverse range of outcomes for the Malaysian economy and local labour market conditions. Such externalities can be mitigated by stronger collaboration among the stakeholders through the establishment of various productivity nexus.

The farmer will need to access freely and easily, the scientific cultivation knowledge, to achieve the economic production yield and a product quality that the customer expects. The farmer also need to access and utilise the tools effectively to assist in making accurate decisions, what he need to do to protect and promote his crop, and to market his crop in the best market places with the best prices.

Unlocking greater productivity within Malaysia's industrial sectors is one of the national strategies in place to drive our continuous economic growth and expansion. In line with this, the Government launched the Malaysia Productivity Blueprint (MPB) in May 2017 as part of the 11th Malaysia Plan.

Within the MPB, nine priority subsectors were identified as presenting high potential growth for our country. In particular, the Electrical and Electronics (E&E) industry, where the Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI) has been at the forefront of generating private public partnerships (PPPs) to drive productivity enhancement initiatives within the sector.

The Electrical & Electronics (E&E) industry is a major subsector of the manufacturing sector, which has grown by leaps and bounds since 1972. The subsector is divided into two main industries; namely, computer, electronic, and optical products, and electrical equipment.

In an effort to boost the E&E sector's contribution to the national economy, the Electrical & Electronics Productivity Nexus (EEPEN) led by industries and supported by the Government was formed in 2017. To further the success of strategies identified by the EEPEN, the Delivery Management Office (DMO) of Malaysia Productivity Corporation (MPC) has undertaken the role to coordinate, monitor and evaluate delivery efforts of the MPB.

Overview
MEPN gets M&E productivity up to speed

As one of the engines running behind economic progress, the Machinery and Equipment (M&E) subsector is among the driving force across sectors, especially in manufacturing and services. It is such a key player in the Industry Revolution 4.0 that should it 'break down', it would not be long before we spin and crash on the highway to global economic collapse.

Perhaps it is this cautiousness that makes the M&E subsector so reluctant to risk. Most of those within the M&E subsector tend to stick to traditional methods of business that 'has worked before'. But in today's fast-paced business environment, the approach of 'If it's not broke, why fix it?' does not do much for productivity. As more developed nations become more competitive and adapting to new technologies, this perspective needs to be challenged so the nation does not get left in the dust.

Gearing up Malaysia's M&E subsector

Addressing this challenge, the M&E Productivity Nexus (MEPN) was created – a solution consisting of four M&E sectoral initiatives identified by the Malaysia Productivity Blueprint (MPB) to boost productivity across companies of all sizes. Led by Mr. Mac Ngan Boon, President of Machinery and Engineering Industries Federation (MEF), the four initiatives are:

1. Set up partnership between government and industry associations to up-skill existing employees;
2. Set up Centres of Excellence for skilled professionals to share industry expertise and develop new technologies;
3. Update domestic product standards to be at par with international standards and enforce compliance; and
4. Set up more product testing facilities to ensure standards are met.

High performance: Focusing on the nuts and bolts

Collaborating with institutions, MEPN has since launched targeted initiatives that tackle problems at its core – from the grassroots.

These impactful initiatives aim to bridge technical skills gaps, establish manufacturing standards, enhance operations, streamline regulatory processes, groom potential companies for the global market and create dialogues on issues faced by the M&E subsector. Working to improve the fundamentals to ensure efficient clockwork, MEPN is hoped to boost productivity levels that are otherwise hindered.







Overview

The global healthcare industry is among the most dynamic and rapidly growing industries in the world economy. Demand for healthcare is likely to expand in the future based on the stimulated demographic shifts such as the increase in the number of elderly people, extended longevity; and a rise in lifestyle diseases. Hence, the consumers' awareness on the importance of healthcare services have grown and accessibility to obtain these services have also improved.

Not too long ago, if you would like to set up a new private hospital, the approval alone required more than 800 days – roughly 2.2 years. But when new regulatory initiatives were introduced in 2017, the whole process was cut down to 300 days in 2019.

Now, imagine if we can reduce this to 100 days.

Faster approval process for new private hospitals

Well, now we can. To boost productivity and economic growth of private healthcare, the Malaysia Productivity Corporation (MPC) supported by the Private Healthcare Productivity Nexus (PHPN) will introduce initiatives that cover three (3) key areas:

- Regulation,
- Technology and Innovation, and
- Workforce and Performance

To speed up the application process to set up a new private hospital, new guidelines and online permit application will be introduced. The improvements will be ready later this year and are expected to shorten the application process to be less than 100 days.

- Better Regulation

Reducing the regulatory burden (and layers of approvals), private healthcare will soon benefit from improved regulation in advertisement practices. This upgrade is expected to make RM2.1 billion in healthcare travel revenue for the country, and boost the economy in sectors such as accommodation, transportation, food and beverages and retail.

- Technology and Innovation

In this area, the initiative brings forward Public-Private Partnership (PPP), a business model that enables public and private hospitals to share resources and facilities. It's a win-win scenario: private sector can participate more and public facilities can be improved!

- Workforce and Performance

A hospital is as good as the people behind it. To help solve the shortage of medical specialists in the country, the initiative will also identify, and help selected private hospitals to be specialty training centres in high demand areas of medicine. To help support this, a standard framework will be developed for private hospitals as specialty training centres.
