TERMS OF REFERENCE

1.0 Background

MPC has been given an opportunity by the Government to undertake BI programs and initiatives for Malaysia starting in 2020, as the Government is keen to embed BI in designing public policy towards a better quality and effective regulation. For Year 2021, MPC plans to develop the Behavioural Insights Guideline as a guidance to the practitioners in applying and implementing Behavioural Insights in public policy.

This new guideline is a practical instrument for policy officials working in ministries, departments and public agencies on what is the process through which the behavioural aspects of a problem can be identified, scoped and addressed.

2.0 The objectives of the project

- i. To translate the BI Guideline (MOSTI) to Bahasa Malaysia to maximize its reach to the stakeholder.

3.0 Project Duration

The project will require approximately three (3) weeks for the complete translation.
